Entrants will be asked the following questions:

1. Project name (10 words max)
2. Explain your idea in one sentence (40 words)
3. Explain your idea in one paragraph (100 words)
4. Explain why your idea is innovative. If your idea is based on an existing concept, explain how your use of that concept is innovative in the country or context where it will be implemented. (250 words)
5. Explain how your idea will empower young people to participate fully in a changing economy and how you would use a place-based approach. (250 words)
6. Explain how you will design and test the idea with potential users to develop it into a sustainable project over the next three years. (250 words)
7. Explain how you will grow your idea in the future so it can reach more people or be replicated by other people across Europe. (150 words)
